All competitors take part at their OWN RISK and are expected to exercise due care at all times and obey all notices displayed.

The organisers accept NO responsibility for any accident, loss or damage to any competitors, spectators, animals or property. It shall be a condition of entry that competitors will hold the organisers blameless and indemnify them against any loss, damage or legal proceedings.

Contour recommends that all exhibitors should have adequate personal sports insurance. All accidents/incidents/falls should be reported to the event organiser.

Exhibitors may not knowingly exhibit any Pony/Horse that has been bred, sold, leased or produced by the judge or his/her immediate family or his/her employer.

An exhibitor may not show an equine in a competition judged by any member of his/her immediate family.

An exhibitor may not show under a judge for whom he/she has produced an equine since 1st October 2008.

A rider may not ride in a class judged by someone for whom he/she has ridden in a competition since the 1st October 2008.

No employee of Contour Exhibitions, Mole Valley Farmers or High Performance Marketing may enter or compete

The judge's decision will be final.

All ridden equines MUST be 4 years old & over.

All Colts / Stallions must be in possession of a current License (unless otherwise governed by the individual Breed Society).

Mountain & Moorland ponies MUST be shown in their natural state and trimming MUST comply with the respective Breed Society Stud Books.

The organisers may divide/amalgamate/cancel classes as they see fit, without prior notice.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry of persons or ponies at the committee's / secretary's discretion and without assigning a reason.

Objections must be in writing and given to the Secretary within 30 minutes of the completion of the relevant class and accompanied with a fee of £10.00 (refundable if the objection is upheld)
